



Off-Site Bus Schedule for SOL Testing – Spring 2018

**Any students who cannot remember
where they are to report for their SOL test
should be directed to the home school office.**

The Advanced Technology Center (ATC), the Technical and Career Education Center (TCE), and the Renaissance Academy (RA) will provide their students with a copy of the schedule and will make it perfectly clear to all students that SOL testing is their first priority. Transportation will continue to be provided for students, but will be adjusted as follows:

ATC, Tech Center, and RA Students

ATC, TCE, and RA Half-Day Students

1st Session: 7:40 – 10:50 a.m. (Non-testers)

- Students **not involved** in SOL testing on any given day **are expected** to report to the ATC, TCE, or RA **at their regular time**.
- Students **who are involved** in SOL testing **will remain at their home school upon completion of testing and will not report to the ATC, Tech Center, or RA**.
- Upon **dismissal** from the ATC, TCE, or RA at **10:50 a.m.**, morning students will be transported back to their home schools for blocks 3 and 4.

2nd Session: 12:00 - 2:00 p.m. (All 2nd session students)

- Students will depart their home high school at approximately 11:30 a.m. for their noon class at the ATC, TCE, or RA.
- Students will be released from the centers at their regularly scheduled 2:00 p.m. dismissal time.

CO-OP/Early Release Students – Students are expected to adjust their schedules and remain at the home school for ALL of their classes. (Block 3 ends at 1:20 p.m.) Any student who plans to leave prior to 1:20 p.m. will be required to check-out through the Attendance Office with a note from a parent.

Governor's School Students – Transportation will be provided at the regularly scheduled times from the high schools.

Transportation Issues

All other students who are NOT involved in testing on a scheduled date during the test window (May 21 – 31, 2018) have the following options:

- Riding the second bus that will be provided for students who choose to attend school for ALL of their regular classes starting at 9:50 a.m. **OR**
- Arriving on the bus at the regularly scheduled time and reporting to a designated location for study hall until 9:40 a.m.

Optional 2nd Bus Run Schedule During High School SOL Testing

When: Monday, May 21, through Thursday, May 31

Who: High school students transported to school from within the school's zone

Regular Schedule

Students who have scheduled SOL tests will report to school at the regular time and follow the testing schedule.

Optional Schedule

Students *not scheduled for testing* on any given day during the testing window of May 21 – 30 may choose to follow one of two options:

Option #1

Students may choose to ride their regular school bus at the usual time. During the SOL testing block (7:20 a.m. - 9:40 a.m.), most students not testing will be assigned to a supervised study hall. Advanced Technology Center and Tech Center students who are not testing should follow their regular schedule.

Option #2

Students may choose to ride the optional second run of their regular school bus. Upon arrival at school at approximately 9:40 a.m., students will go to scheduled classes since the SOL testing block will be over.

Please note that there is no optional second bus run for academy buses.
